Choose a stone and place it on the “altar” (in the bowl) as you proclaim something that God has done. If you want, spend time in prayer thanking God for the things He has done.

Repentance and Consecration

Joshua 3:5

Ask God if there is anything you need to repent of. Write it on a piece of paper, then burn the paper (in the can) and anoint yourself with the anointing oil.

Chosen, Called, and Appointed by God

Joshua was chosen by God and reminded more than once to “be strong and courageous.” What are some things (fears, thoughts, etc.) that can hold you/us back from your/our calling in Christ? Speak those things out loud as you remove a piece of the Jenga game, signifying that we are getting rid of those things! See if you can continue to do this until the game tumbles down!

Joshua 1:3-6

As Joshua led the people of Israel into the promised land following God's call, we as KKI want to move forward in the calling God has for us as a ministry. Spend time seeking God, asking Him if He wants to speak anything to you about the future and direction of KKI.

Also, spend some time listening to God for your own personal life. What is the inheritance God has for you? What does He want to say to you during this weekend here?
